We will try to make our school a safe place for you to learn in.

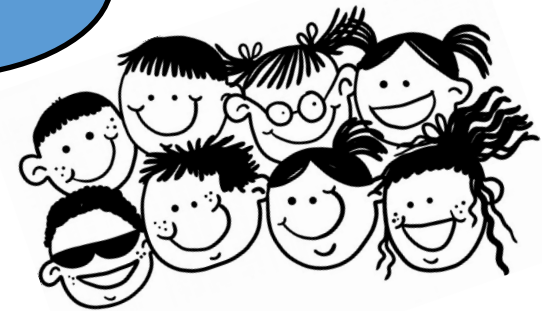
We want to make sure that you are safe, at home as well as at school.

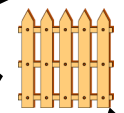

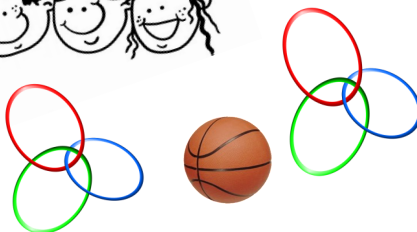
