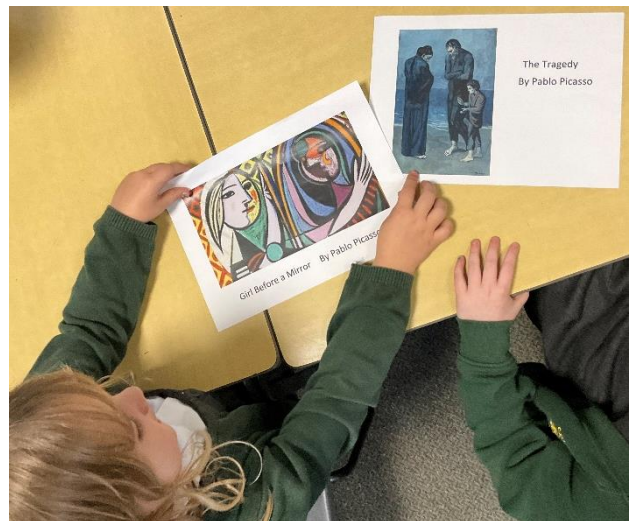
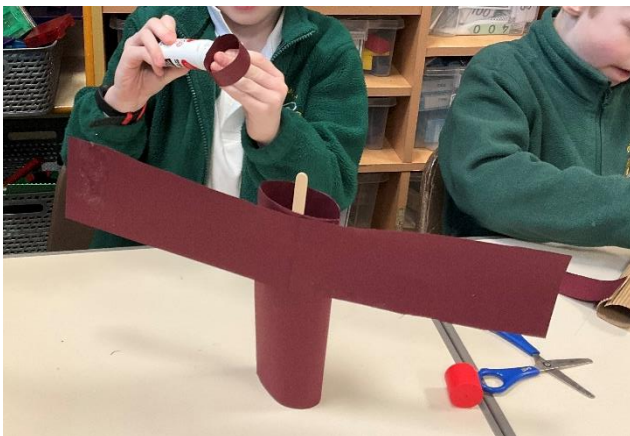

and approach

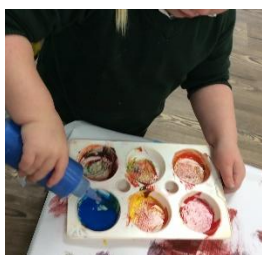

ourselves in our learning.

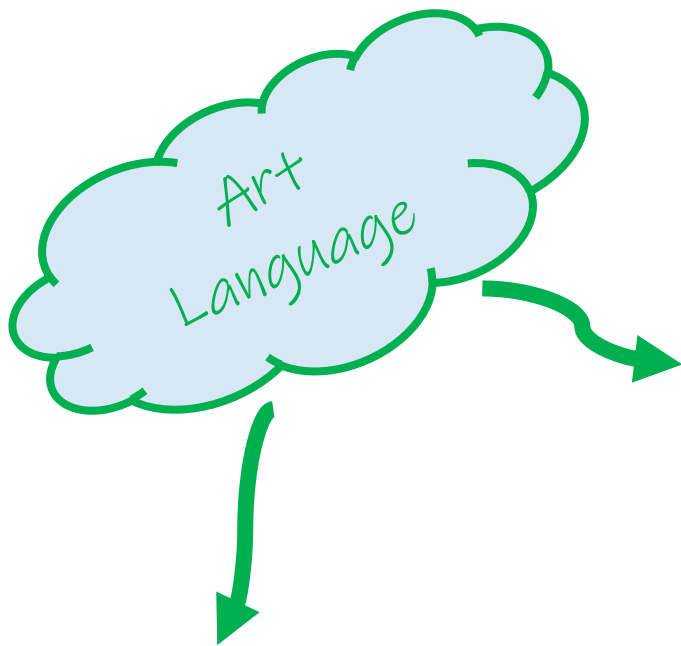
Art in our

Art in our Nursery & Reception classes is covered in the 'Expressive Arts & Design' area of the EYFS Curriculum.



It is introduced indirectly through engaging, hands on activities that encourage every child to explore, discuss and create using a variety of media and materials both indoors and outdoors.



Our children are encouraged to develop their vocabulary to describe their art, by observing, discussing and explaining through first-hand practical discoveries. Through Quality First Teaching, we ensure all children are engaged and involved in art and design learning and discovery.
